Cost no money upfront but 6.5% of fee plus \$1. Other plan is an upfront fee plus a smaller percentage. Maximum \$5 per applicant. ActiveNewtork.com

Jim H: Overall, we were short about \$8 per player annualized. Jack suggested we may need to adjust the early registration discount. Discussed increasing rates \$10 for next season.
